Notes:

1. High schools must follow the same bell schedule so high school students and teachers can attend/teach classes on other campuses.
2. Principals are responsible for scheduling teachers who travel between campuses.
3. Senior exams will be May 24-May 30 and grades 9- 11 exams will be May 29-June 1. Two exams, approximately two hours in length, will be scheduled for each day with exception of May 29 for grades 9-11 and May 30 for seniors.
4. Breakfast will be served each day, May 29-June 1. Lunch will be served Tuesday, May 29.
5. On early release days, May 30-June 1, students who have their own transportation or rides may leave at 11:30 a.m. Students who ride the bus will be transported at 1:00 p.m. Schools must supervise students during the 11:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. waiting period.
6. NAC shuttles for Cy-Springs and Jersey Village will leave Langham Creek and Cy-Ridge at 11:15; all other NAC students will leave the NAC campus at 11:30 to arrive for bus run at 1:00 p.m.
7. Carlton's vocational classes will operate normal schedule on Monday, May 29th running classes at Periods 1st/2nd and Period 3rd/4th. On early release days, May 30-June 1, the vocational classes will operate a modified schedule running only Periods 1st/2nd; there will be no 3rd/4th Period classes and these students will need to remain on their home campus. All Carlton Classes will have early release at 1:00 pm on Friday, June 1.
8. If a student is taking a class at another campus, prior arrangements should be made to get the final exam to the home campus and determine who will proctor the final exam. Students should not drive between campuses to complete final exams. Courses with performance-based or project-based exams may need to be administered in advanced.
